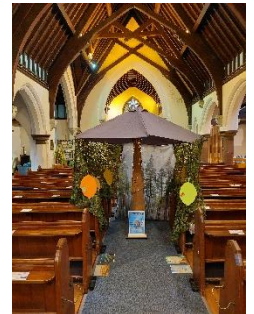
Our new dossiers have been sent to our schools and we are busy taking bookings for 2024-25!
